**GEOSISMICA 2020, REMTECH EXPO, THE NEWS OF NEXT EDITION**

**The agenda of the 14th edition of RemTech Expo is enriched by new and focal themes related to risk mitigation of the works of road and railway infrastructures and the urgent need for a framework rule for the reconstruction of earthquake-affected territories. The experts talked about that at the meeting of the Technical Scientific Committee of GEOSISMICA.**

On February 14th, at the headquarter of Emilia Romagna Region, the Technical Scientific Committee of Geosismica met with the coordination of Eng. **Gianluca Loffredo** supported by Dr. **Valerio Comerci** (Ispra).

The meeting was animated by some of the leading experts and representatives of the Institutions, Regions, Associations, Foundations, Universities, Research Centers and of course Companies operating in the reference contexts.

The most important innovations introduced this year by the program of edition 2020 of Geosismica, concern the CSLPP guidelines for the **inspections, monitoring and maintenance** of road works, the need for a framework rule to regulate the reconstruction of areas affected by natural disasters through a number of fundamental invariants, the dissemination of sustainability protocols and the role of the GBC Green Building Council Italia both in infrastructure and in the socio-economic context of an area in general, the stabilization of fiscal incentives for requalification work, as well as the new seismic hazard maps that will deeply influence the projects.

**Silvia Paparella**, General Manager of RemTech Expo, introduces the meeting with a description of the event, the thematic drivers and the impact it has had over the years on legislators, businesses, trade associations and the academic world.

**Gianluca Loffredo**, coordinator of the scientific committee, opens the work by illustrating the essential issues addressed in previous sessions of Geosismic and focuses on the Leitmotif of the upcoming edition which sees an increasing participation of road, rail, aqueduct and energy infrastructure managers. It illustrates the most topical issues: the **guidelines** of the CSLPP Consiglio Superiore dei Lavori Pubblici in phase of being completed for the risk management of road infrastructure works of art, the need for a framework standard for post-emergency management, the role of the Demanio Agency for the management of public property and the lack of stabilization of the so-called earthquake and eco bonus fiscal measures.

All the participants have contributed with interesting suggestions, always calling for collaboration, participation and a proactive approach to the legislator. **Gianluca Loffredo** closed the session by proposing to discuss with Ispra and Casa Italia in order to create a permanent thematic tables of discussion of the issues addressed.

The day closes with full satisfaction and with the launch of actions aimed to consolidate and expand the panel of technical, strategic and regulatory opportunities for all stakeholders involved.
